2. Applications for demonstrator space must be postmarked no later than March 15, 2010.
3. Space is limited, and the show committee will be assigning space. Specific requests will be considered but not guarantee of accommodating such requests.
4. Demonstrations at the booth are limited to the confines of the booth space.
5. The Show Committee reserves the right to reject and/or restrict the vendor due to sale of inappropriate items.
6. Failure to comply with these rules may prohibit any vendor from future participation in any Tennessee Volunteer Gourd shows.
